

What to do with your new tablet

1. Locate the cords at the bottom of the box the longer cord is what you will use to charge the tablet.
2. Connect in the longer cord to the tablet and plug the adapter into the wall (a blue light should come on signifying the tablet is charging)
3. Turn on your new tablet with the power button on the top corner of the device.
4. The tablet will now boot up while the tablet is booting it will ask you what side you would like to boot your device in Windows or android (the symbol of the flag or the robot)

Windows

1. Once you have selected windows symbol it will open onto the windows side of the tablet.
2. At the bottom right of the screen you will see a three curved lines with a star above it double tap the symbol.
3. Select a source of Wi-Fi from the list displayed (you can find free sources of Wi-Fi at your local library, coffee house or fast food restaurant.)
4. The windows side of your tablet is good to go.

Android

1. Once you have selected the android symbol it will boot to the android side of the tablet.
2. The first time you open the android side of the tablet it will open to the set up menu follow the directions and it will help you set up your tablet.
3. The android side of your tablet should now be good to go.
